◆Application Eligibility and Requirements

1. The applicant must be a sophomore or above.
2. The applicant must have maintained an academic average each semester of at least 78, and conduct of 80 or higher.
3. Students minoring in this department must complete at least 30 credits to fulfill the minor requirement.
4. If compulsory courses for the student's minor overlap with those for the major, the student must use this form to apply for recognition of such courses toward both requirements, and to select an additional elective course. After authorization, students must still complete at least 30 credits to fulfill the minor requirement.
